Theme for the month

The theme for all the groups for the month of September is **PLANTS**.

Playgroup: The kids will learn about different plant names, importance of watering and gardening.

Nursery: Here the kids will learn the basics of gardening and how a plant grows from a seed. They will also talk about the importance of air, water and sunlight for the growth of the plant.

PP1: The kids will do more experiments related to the theme and will observe the plant growth from the seed. They will also talk about the importance of plants and will discuss about the gardener as a community helper.
